1. Definition of Integrity


- a. The quality of possessing and steadfastly adhering to high moral principles or professional standards (Encarta)
- b. Faithful support of a standard of values.
- c. The idea of singleness of heart or mind (Matt. 5:8; 6:22; James 1:7–8; 4:8) (Holman Bible Dictionary)

2. Integrity Means:

- a. Treating people fairly and honestly. (Leviticus 19:35-36, Deuteronomy 25:15, Proverbs 16:11-13)
- b. Giving your word and keeping it. (Exodus 8:28-32)

3. Considerations

- a. The Lord hates lies and lack of integrity (Zechariah 8:16-17).
- b. It may be difficult to maintain your integrity (Job 2:3, 2:9, Prov 29:10)
- c. Your character can be corrupted by bad company (1 Cor 15:33)


